Introduction

This media guide aims to provide media representatives with specific information about media-related procedures and resources available during the 2017 Maltese Presidency of the Council of the European Union.

This document describes the procedure media representatives have to go through in order to register and be accredited for the Maltese EU Presidency. Media facilities and services available at the Media Centre, information about the host broadcaster and the official photographer, and the general rules and guidelines for media representatives are also available. The guide includes the official programme, practical information, a list of spokespersons and diplomatic missions, floor plans and links to available information tools.

Essential information related to the Maltese EU Presidency and the Media can be found on the official website www.eu2017.mt. The media kit and brand guidelines are available for download on this site.

General Information

For the very first time, between the months of January and June 2017, the Council of the European Union will find its political hub in the heart of the Mediterranean. The Maltese Islands will be welcoming approximately 20,000 delegates from all over the European Union and will be hosting approximately 1,800 meetings in Malta and Brussels, over 220 of which are set to take place in Malta. The Maltese EU Presidency will make use of several venues, most of which are a treasured part of Malta's heritage, narrating its history and the history of its people on their sturdy walls.

The main venue will be the majestic Grand Master's Palace in the heart of Valletta, an architectural treasure that saw the building of Malta's grand capital city. As the Knights of the Order of St. John, the Governors of England, and the Presidents of the Republic of Malta have walked through its glorious, awe-inspiring halls, so will the delegates during Malta's turn holding the Presidency of the Council of the European Union.

Malta will encounter great responsibilities in the face of this term during which it will be holding the Presidency. The term comes at a time of turbulence and threats, with the effects of Brexit just around the corner and terrorism ever hovering over the continent. Malta faces the responsibility and the opportunity of using its strong, independent political voice and its decisive sense of direction to bring the Member States closer, resulting in a stronger and more united Union. At the same time, Malta faces the opportunity of furthering its national priorities in the context of the priorities of the Union.

Registration and Accreditation

All members of the press wishing to attend any meeting and/or event related to the 2017 Maltese Presidency of the Council of the European Union need to be registered and accredited for each meeting. Members of the press must register on <https://media.eu2017.mt>.

Media representatives are only required to register their profile once. Once they have logged onto their personal profile, applicants must select each meeting they wish to attend. Applicants will then receive an email confirming accreditation. Press will be asked to present this accreditation confirmation email together with an identification document in order to access the Media Centre.

Media Accreditation Procedure

In order to be able to register to attend events, applicants must set up a new account. They will be asked to enter their e-mail address, whereby they will receive an account activation e-mail. Applications for accreditation must be submitted by no later than 3 weeks prior to the first event they wish to attend, and any change in personal details will result in the loss of accreditation. Therefore, any changes required must be submitted at least 10 days prior to the event.

In order to be accredited each applicant must enter all mandatory fields including the following:

- Name & Surname;
- Date of Birth;
- Passport or Identity Card Number;
- Mother and Father's Names;

- A copy of the Press Card or Commissioning letter from the Editor in Chief;
- A photo in .JPG, .PNG, .GIF or .BMP file format at a maximum file size of 3MB on a white background.

Accreditation is subject to security checks. Any queries related to accreditation must be addressed to media.accreditation@eu2017.mt or +356 2540 2700.

Accreditation Badges

Accreditation badges will only be issued to individuals who have successfully completed the registration process and have been accredited. The badges must be collected in person from the Accreditation desk in the Media Centre upon presentation of proof of identity:

- **your valid passport** (or if you are a national of a Member State of the European Union, an EFTA country or an EEA country, your valid national identity card); or
- **your valid press card** (or if you are a media representative from a country which does not issue press cards, a letter in English or French signed by the editor-in-chief of your media organisation, specifying your professional status and that you come to cover the 2017 Maltese Presidency of the Council of the EU);
- for media representatives of Maltese nationality or registered as residents in Malta ONLY please present **your valid press card**.

No accreditation badge will be issued if you cannot present any of these documents.

All participants will undergo a security check.

Once provided, this access badge must be worn at all times in the Media Centre and any other venue.

Late Accreditation

Late accreditation will be available exclusively under unforeseen circumstances at the Late Accreditation Centre. Approval is subject to security checks.

Accreditation in Brussels and Luxembourg

Accreditation for meetings being held in Brussels and Luxembourg is managed by the General Secretariat of the Council of the European Union. Different rules and procedures may apply depending on the type of event. For more information please follow the link: <http://www.consilium.europa.eu/en/press/accreditation/>.

Visa

Should a visa be required in order to attend any of the events being held as part of the Maltese EU Presidency programme, it is the person's responsibility to access the visa website in order to obtain the necessary application. This would need to be filed at the diplomatic mission of the main destination or country of first entry into the Schengen area, or its representation. The applicant must ensure that the application is submitted within the established deadlines.

Should an applicant foresee that a visa will be required for attendance to any of the events being held as part of the official Maltese EU Presidency programme, this should clearly be indicated in the registration form on the Accreditation Portal. Upon successful completion of the process, the Presidency Unit will issue a supporting letter confirming accreditation.

Media Centre

The Media Centre is situated on the ground floor of the Grand Master's Palace, accessible from Archbishop's Street. The facilities and services available at the Media Centre are as follows:

Accreditation desk and security screening

The accreditation desk is situated at the entrance of the Media Centre. Members of the press can collect their accreditation badges either a day prior to the Informal Meeting or on the day.

Information and Press Desk

The Information Desk will be providing useful information, services and assistance on the following:

- General Information;
- Agenda of the Day;
- Registration for Media opportunities;
- Booking of Media booths; and
- Technical Support.

Maltese EU Presidency Staff Office

The Press Office of the Maltese EU Presidency is situated on the ground floor of the Media Centre, just behind the security screening area.

Press workstations

There is a total of 250 workstations spread over two floors, having high bandwidth wired and wireless internet access and printing facilities. These workstations are equipped with universal power socket outlets (220V) together with wired data socket outlets. Technical support is also available.

Media representatives may reserve work spaces by means of a label indicating their name and media organisation. The press office of the 2017 Maltese Presidency of the Council of the EU cannot reserve work spaces. Reserved spaces not occupied at the beginning of the proceedings of the event may be taken by others.

Catering Facilities

Meals and refreshments are available in the lounge area situated on the first floor. Coffee, tea, water, soft drinks and light snacks will be available around the clock.

TV/Radio Booth Facilities

There are 11 media booths equipped with universal power outlets, wired and wireless internet access, LAN connection and a monitor/TV. The booths will be wired to receive live video and audio feeds (floor language and translations) from the meetings covered by the Host Broadcaster. Pool signal in HD is available in the media booths. Radio booths will also be equipped with ISDN lines. The media booths can be reserved on a first come, first served basis by sending an e-mail to hostbroadcaster@eu2017.mt.

Upon request to the host broadcaster, media representatives can be provided with fixed line telephony services, premium internet services and TV services.

Stand-up Positions

There are 4 fully equipped stand-up positions and these will be rigged on demand. They are fully equipped with a camera, microphone and lighting. There is also space available for non-live and non-equipped stand-up positions. Stand-up positions can be booked directly with the host broadcaster at hostbroadcaster@eu2017.mt.

Other available facilities situated on the first floor at the Media Centre include the following:

- Host Broadcaster's office;
- Master Control room;
- Pool signal in HD available in the media booths. Lounge;
- Printing booth with 6 multifunction printers;
- Storage facilities for personal belongings;
- Lounge.

A press conference room having 80 seats and 2 press briefing rooms are also available.

Opening hours

The Media Centre will open at 7 am every day, and will close 4 hours after the last press opportunity of the day.

Host services: Broadcasting & Photography

Host Broadcaster's Coverage of Events

The Public Broadcasting Services (PBS) will be engaged as the official host broadcaster for the 2017 Maltese Presidency of the Council of the EU. PBS operates TVM and TVM2 television channels and the Radio Malta, Radio Malta 2 and Magic Malta radio stations. PBS is an official member of the European Broadcasting Union, and will provide accredited media with free of charge audiovisual material from the Informal Ministerial Meetings and other high-level events taking place in Malta.

Media coverage opportunities

There are several media coverage opportunities available for every Informal Ministerial Meeting, e.g.

- Doorstep;
- Handshake (host photographer / broadcaster only);
- Tour de table (only video / photo press);
- Family Photo (host photographer / broadcaster only);
- Press conferences as per the official programme;

NB: Not all opportunities are available at all informal meetings.

PBS will offer the possibility of transmitting broadcast content on radio or TV channels. More information will be provided in due course.

Host Photographer

During the high-level events, the Host Photographer will be based at the Media Centre. Documentation of all the main events of the 2017 Maltese EU Presidency will include Informal Ministerial and other high-level meetings.

Media regulations

A number of strict rules have been set for media representatives and must be adhered to for the duration of the 2017 Maltese Presidency of the Council of the EU. Media representatives will also be expected to follow guidelines provided by the Security Staff. Failure to comply with the regulations will result in the right to withdraw accreditation.

The rules are as follows:

- The media badges should be worn visibly at all times throughout the event;
- Media representatives must follow any instructions given by the Presidency and security staff. The Presidency's decision is final;
- Media representatives have limited access to the venue. Certain locations, parts of the programme and press conferences may be restricted. The exact locations are available at the media information desk;
- Access to some media opportunities may be restricted due to limited space. If this is the case, press pools may be created where press can register at the media desk;
- Media Representatives must arrive on time in order to be granted access;
- Availability of workstations in the Media Centre is on a first come, first served basis;
- The 2017 Maltese Presidency of the Council of the EU will not be held responsible for any lost or damaged property;
- Media will only be able to take photographs or film at the start of certain events. The personnel will inform the media when it would be appropriate to leave. Media

representatives are requested to be respectful, quiet and discreet. Media hosts will determine where the media may sit and walk in each location;

- It is forbidden to photograph or record, either by camera or mobile phone, confidential documents or items which belong to other participants;
- Media representatives are not allowed to approach event participants and spokespersons with video or audio equipment (smart phones included) that is already recording, without asking for their verbal or written consent prior to turning the equipment on. If the participant or spokesperson refuses a request for a live interview or recording, the media must adhere to their wishes;
- Media representatives are expected not to block entrances, corridors or restricted areas designated for delegates and dignitaries;
- Security personnel must not be filmed or photographed at any time;
- Presidency staff will not be threatened or harassed. Should such an event occur, media representatives will be dismissed from the Media Centre and further legal actions may be taken.

Practical Information

Accommodation

MALTA EU2017 has no special arrangements for media representatives regarding hotel reservations. Please bear in mind that hotels may be fully booked well in advance.

Transport

Security Measures

The Malta Police Force will establish a security cordon around the Press Centre and the Mediterranean Conference Centre and will deny access to anyone without an accreditation badge and identity document.
